E0008	E70A10	Perimeter Fence and Suroundings Locn.:On Site	Perimeter fencing damaged and holed in places with protruding wire. Ground uneven in places. 1 x bench positioned close to perimeter fencing, recommend to be a minimum of 1000 mm as per BS EN1176. Advise risk assessment be carried to determine the implementation of calming measures, as there is direct access to the main road beyond the park gate. Signage to be improved
