KEY AIMS AND OBJECTIVES 2024/25

<u>Community Led Book Service</u> – to continue to support Book Cycle in getting a venue in Billinge with aim to get book service up and running

<u>Dam Slacks</u> - make improvements to the Dam Slacks playground including commemorative benches to mark the Parish Council's 50th Anniversary. To also look at fundraising to make improvements.

50th Anniversary of the Parish Council – to celebrate by holding a range of events including amongst others:

Past Councillors Afternoon Team;

Rainford v Billinge Cricket Match and inter-Parish games Snooker, darts,etc; Commemorative Services at St Aidans & St Marys;
