

Actions from Fire Risk assessment Aug 2026

Hello Karen,

Thanks for the reply and information to complete the Fire Risk Assessment.

If a skip is to be brought in then all grass, weeds and hedge cuttings should be disposed of including the mounds of previous cuttings near the Gable end, to reduce the risk of 'Hay stack fires' (spontaneous combustion of organic matter)

I recommend that weeds growing on the Gable end should be removed to reduce the risk of building damage.

Once the rear of the building is cleared then an area away from the main building needs allocating to store the wooden fencing (piles of wood against buildings is a gift to arsonists)

I will call at Damsacks and remove the remnants of the book-box that puts children at risk of injury.
